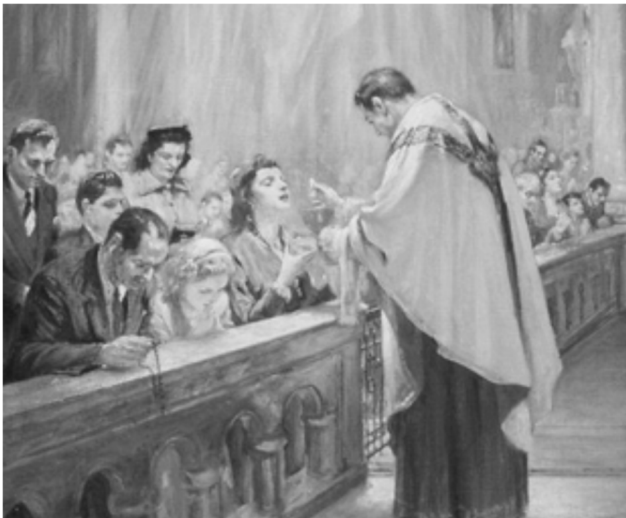

CORPUS CHRISTI AND HOLY COMMUNION

As we look forward to an end of virus restrictions and to a resumption of Holy Communion in the traditional manner, what better time than Corpus Christi to ask:

If we truly believe in the Real Presence of the living Body of Christ (*Corpus Christi*), how else should we receive Him, except on the tongue while kneeling in reverent adoration?

Cardinal Robert Sarah—the Vatican prefect in charge of Roman Catholic liturgy—cites **Saints John Paul II and Mother Teresa of Calcutta** in support of this venerable practice that dates back well over a thousand years.



As we believe, so we receive.

Card. Sarah recalls that **“John Paul II always forced himself to kneel in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament.** He needed the help of others to bend the knee and then rise up. Until his last days.”

And that **“seeing Christians who receive Holy Communion in their hands filled Mother Teresa with sadness and pain.** She herself said: *“when I enter into the world, the thing that saddens me the most is to see people receive communion in their hands.”*

Card. Sarah states that the “present legislation contains the indult [giving special permission] to receive the Eucharist standing and in the hand—as an *exception* to universal Church law— but **receiving It kneeling and on the tongue is still the norm for Catholics of the Roman Rite”.**

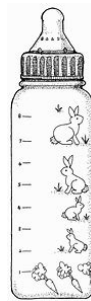
