New required safe-environment training

CMG connect is a new web-based platform that helps ensure that all employees, volunteers, and anyone that participates in a parish group are trained to recognize behavior patterns of potential abusers and provide proactive measures for preventing abuse in any context. This program replaces the Virtus program that was previously used by the Diocese of Knoxville.

Everyone who volunteers or participates in a parish group at Holy Ghost age 18 or older is required to complete this online training. The training video consists of three stories based on real-life situations and is intended to educate the viewer about methods of grooming, desensitization, bullying, and neglect which can lead to abuse. Each part of the video is followed by a short questionnaire. Training is available in both English and Spanish.

Please follow the steps below to register and complete the required training and background check:

1. Visit <https://dioknox.org/safe-environment/>
2. Click on the link that best describes your relationship to the parish. If you volunteer or participate with a parish group and do not handle money, click the link "Volunteer, no financial role." If you volunteer or participate with a parish group and are responsible for collecting money at parish events, counting the weekly collection, or serve as a treasurer for your parish group, click on the link "Volunteer, with financial role."
3. If you have not had a background check since July 2015, please also complete the background check after completing the required training.
4. Once your training is complete, please download the completion certificate and forward a copy to the parish office.

If you are employed or volunteer at another parish and have already completed the training, please forward a copy of the completion certificate to the parish office. For more information or assistance with completing the registration or training, please contact the parish office at 865-522-2205.

Nueva formación necesaria en medio ambiente Seguro

CMG connect es una nueva plataforma basada en la web que ayuda a garantizar que todos los empleados, voluntarios y cualquier persona que participe en un grupo parroquial estén capacitados para reconocer los patrones de comportamiento de los posibles abusadores y proporcionar medidas proactivas para prevenir el abuso en cualquier contexto. Este programa reemplaza el programa Virtus que fue utilizado previamente por la Diócesis de Knoxville.

Todos los que sean voluntarios o participen en un grupo parroquial a partir de 18 años de edad, deberán completar esta capacitación en línea. El video de capacitación consta de tres historias basadas en situaciones de la vida real y está destinado a educar al espectador sobre métodos de acoso, desensibilización, intimidación y negligencia que pueden conducir a abusos. Cada parte del video es seguida por un breve cuestionario. La formación está disponible tanto en inglés como en español.

Siga los pasos a continuación para registrarse y completar la capacitación y verificación de antecedentes requeridas:

1. Visita <https://dioknox.org/safe-environment/>
2. Haga clic en el enlace que mejor describa su relación con la parroquia. Si usted es voluntario o participa con un grupo parroquial y no maneja el dinero, haga clic en el enlace "Voluntario, sin función financiera". Si usted es voluntario o participa con un grupo parroquial y es responsable de recolectar dinero en eventos parroquiales, contar la colección semanal, o servir como tesorero para su grupo parroquial, haga clic en el enlace "Voluntario, con papel financiero".
3. Si no ha recibido una verificación de antecedentes desde julio de 2015, complete también la verificación de antecedentes después de completar el entrenamiento requerido.
4. Una vez que su capacitación esté completa, descargue el certificado de finalización y reenvíe una copia a la oficina parroquial.

Si usted está empleado o voluntario en otra parroquia y ya ha completado la capacitación, por favor reenvíe una copia del certificado de finalización a la oficina parroquial.
